For example, to cite both print books and ebooks, use the books and reference works category and then choose the appropriate type of work (i.e., book) and follow the relevant example (e.g., whole authored book). Reference examples are covered in Chapter 10 of the APA Publication Manual, Seventh Edition.

Reference Examples - APA Style

Title the page References, centered at the top (no bold, italics, quotation marks, etc.). References should be in a hanging indent format, meaning that the first line of each reference is set flush left and subsequent lines are indented, like this: Lorem ipsum dolor sit amet, consectetur adipiscing elit. Etiam at porttitor massa.

Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

Use this format for articles from news websites. Common examples are BBC News, Bloomberg, CNN, HuffPost, MSNBC, Reuters, Salon, and Vox. These sites do not have associated daily or weekly newspapers. Use the newspaper article category for articles from newspaper websites such as The New York Times or The Washington Post.

Webpage on a Website References - APA Style

Reference List. In-text Citation. Basic Format:Last name, A. A. (Year).Title of article. Title of Journal. Volume number (issue number if available), pages.Example: Scruton, R. (1996).The eclipse of listening. The New Criterion, 15(3), 5-13. Note: The name of the author is reversed with the last name first followed by the initials.

APA Journal Citation | APA Format

Accordingly, the following is my summary of the key points for including APA citations in a paper, as per the APA Publication Manual.

APA citation style for internet reference resources.

Based on APA Publication Manual, 7th Edition (2019). The Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association is the APA's official citation guide and provides a more detailed explanation of how to use APA style. The manual is unfortunately not available online, but reference copies are available in all 17 University System of Maryland libraries.

Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

In-text Citation - APA Quick Citation Guide - Library ...

For the reference list, not all the elements listed may be present in a specific reference. You only need to include the available information from the source. In-Text Citation . In-text citation is usually written in a parenthesis with the last name of the author and year separated by a comma. (Kelly, 2009)

One author, two publications. Order by year of publication, the earlier one first. Same year of publication for both - add 'a' and 'b' after the year, inside the brackets. Include this in the in text citation. example: Baheti, J. R. (2001a).
