Remove the belt. Replace the tensioner and the idler and fit the camshaft pulley locking tool to secure the location of the two camshaft pulleys, so that they remain in the exact position at which their non-roundness will work to the advantage of the engine (otherwise they will increase belt tension fluctuation rather than reduce it). The dots on both pulleys (at +/- 3 and 9 o'clock (and 12 o'clock)) will not be perfectly lined up.

A timing belt change involves the disassembling and checking of many other parts of the engine which makes this a rather tricky job. How common is a cambelt or timing belt replacement? On average, the belt could be expected to last for 60,000 miles, or six years, almost regardless of the vehicle's make or model.

To refit the cam belt you reverse the process, however there are some points to note, the first of these is you need to slacken the center bolts of both the inlet and exhaust cam pulleys so they are able to move a little and then tighten the cam belt using the cam belt tensioner before re-tightening the center bolts on the cam shafts.
