Lymphatic system and immune system are two systems of the body with different functions. The main difference between lymphatic and immune system is that lymphatic system is a part of the immune system whereas immune system defends the body from foreign materials. The lymphatic system comprises lymph, lymph nodes, lymph vessels, and some other organs such as the thymus, spleen, tonsils, vermiform appendix, and Peyer's patch.

### Difference Between Lymphatic and Immune System ...

-Lymph fluid arises from blood plasma, forced out of capillary beds by osmotic pressures. - Left behind is interstitial fluid which is picked up by lymph capillaries, after which it is called lymph. - Lymph is taken by lymphatic vessels until it is returned to the venous system through the right lymphatic duct or thoracic duct.
