2. Title. Always include the full title of the source, including subtitles (separated by a colon and space). Use title...

For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. MLA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the page number from which the quotation or paraphrase is taken, for example: (Smith 163).
